Notes:

Implementing legislation is identified by date and chapter number (e.g. 2003, c.F-17). If the entry is not annotated with the letter M, P, S or E, the Uniform Act was enacted without significant modifications. M indicates that a Uniform Act has been enacted with modifications. P indicates that a Uniform Act has been enacted in part. S indicates that provisions that are similar in effect to the Uniform Act have been enacted. E indicates that existing legal rules were already similar in effect when the Uniform Act was adopted.

Uniform Acts typically fall within provincial and territorial jurisdiction rather than federal jurisdiction. Implementation at the federal level (“Canada” in the table below) is rarely called for. Implementation in Quebec may differ from implementation elsewhere because of differences between the underlying civil law framework in Quebec and the common law framework elsewhere.
